Registration and Modesty Agreement

By registering you are agreeing to the following guidelines:

1. Boys must wear formal attire; although it doesn't have to be a tux, formal is required.
2. Keep the dresses formal and classy!
3. Dresses may be **NO shorter** than 2 inches from the top of the knee cap.
4. **Tube dresses** or **two piece mid-drift exposing** will not be permitted.
5. Dresses may not be cut **below bra strap level in the back**.
6. Although strapless dresses ARE allowed, they must be worn with a shall, shrug, or scarf. Remember to think of your own comfort when choosing your dress, so to avoid any uncomfortable situations for you.
